Standards Agreement Policy

All parents, volunteers, youth workers, and youth participants are required to read and sign the **Standards Agreement Policy**. Failure to sign this policy will result in the inability for you or your child to participate in activities implemented by God of Deliverance Ministries Youth Department.

EXPECTATIONS

- 1. All youth participants are expected to follow directions given by the instructors, team leaders, counselors and youth workers.
- 2. All youth participants are expected to show respect and a positive attitude towards peers and youth workers.
- 3. All youth participants are expected to partake in church activities in order to be considered for special trips.
- 4. Parents are expected to sign a consent form whenever youth participants take a trip. The **Standards Agreement Policy** is expected to be followed during all trips.

NO TOLERANCE RULES

- 5. The use of profanity, name calling and foul language will not be tolerated at any time.
- 6. Keep hands and feet to yourself at all times. Pushing, shoving, hitting, kicking, fighting, etc., will not be tolerated at any time.
- 7. Weapons of any sort (guns, knives, pocket knives, etc) or such toys are not allowed.
- 8. Improper and/or illegal materials (magazines, drugs, etc.) will not be tolerated.
- 9. Gossiping and/or spreading rumors will not be tolerated.
- 10. Sexual misconduct of any type will not be tolerated (sexual harassment, acts of sexual violence, sexual exploitation, etc.)
- 11. Public Display of Affection (PDA): No sitting on laps, no kissing, no touching of others' private parts, and/or hugging and holding hands that result in distractive behaviors.

STANDARDS

- 12. We start and end on time.
- 13. Electronic games and devices must be turned off during youth meetings and activities.
- 14. Personal items should be labeled. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 15. No music allowed that does not represent or glorify God.
- 16. Each meeting and/or youth activity will open and close with prayer. You may be called upon to lead in prayer.

- 17. We let each other finish, no interruptions.
- 18. We listen to each other and respect each other's differences in opinion.
- 19. Notify a youth worker if you will not be able to attend an event or meeting that you are expected to be present at.

DRESS CODE

- 1. All youth participants are expected to follow the 4-B's rule: No breasts, butt, boxers, and bellies visible.
- 2. No spaghetti straps (no bra straps showing).
- 3. Guys: T-shirts must stay on (unless swimming).
- 4. Girls: One piece bathing suits. No bikinis.
- 5. No hot pants or short shorts.
- 6. No miniskirts.
- 7. No undergarments exposed (thongs, panties, bras, boxers).
- 8. No provocative clothing. No clothing with offensive print.

DEFINITIONS:

- 1. Youth Workers: Youth workers include both youth and adults that are volunteers, counselors, instructors, and leaders within the God of Deliverance Youth department.
- 2. Youth Participants: Includes all youth members of God of Deliverance Ministries that participate in activities within the youth department.
- 3. Volunteers: Includes anyone, youth and/or adult that is not an active member at God of Deliverance Ministries whom assists with youth activities.
